From the First Vice Chair Group Autonomy

Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or AA as a whole."

AA groups are autonomously functioning entities tied together only by the spirit and practice of AA principles. Each group may decide for itself what it understands those principles to mean, and how they might be put into practice.

The cherry-picking of AA principles is nowhere more evident than when we talk about "Tradition 4." AAs commonly assert group autonomy under this Tradition to allow a course of action, but sometimes without thought to the affect that course might have beyond the group.

In our responsibility to the welfare of other local AA groups and the greater Fellowship, we are reminded of our part in something greater than ourselves or our individual home group. We are part of the chain of recovery reaching back to the co-founders, and, hopefully, reaching into the future. Individual recovery depends on our unity as a Fellowship. In this, we are each individually and our groups collectively custodians of AA's message and program. We are charged to pass it on intact.

I am reminded of the black eye given AA by a group in Washington, DC. Seems they decided to include a very active "13th Step" in their program, an action among others which eventually made the national media. There are lesser examples closer to home, one where a home group disregards the impression member behavior made on a group's neighbors in allowing loud post meeting gatherings to disrupt neighborhood quiet, or think nothing of allowing members to deposit cigarette butts in the shrubbery or on the street. I recall too a new group starting up in the same church where there was already an established AA group. Similarly, the dangers of affiliation persist. Unfortunately, other greater or lesser examples abound. "Every group [has] the right to be wrong."

Each AA group is a guardian of AA's program. My program teaches me to try to be a better person, including my participation in group, family, job and community. Let's stay mindful of the totality of AA's "Tradition 4," including the part that reminds us we are part of a greater whole.
