#### From the First Vice Chair -Wheelchair Access to Meetings

The symbol to the left is generally understood to represent full access to a site or service for individuals using a wheelchair consistent with the guidelines of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). It means that things like parking, building entry, rest facilities, water fountains and public phones are fully available to individuals using a wheelchair without barrier and unaided consistent with ADA standards. Similarly, Nassau Intergroup uses this symbol in its meeting list to denote AA meetings which are believed to be accessible.

NI is reaching out to all groups, but particularly those currently listed as accessible.

Does your group's meeting place meet the following "minimal definition" of accessibility? An unaided individual in a wheelchair can: Enter the building and get to the meeting room (no steps, a gently inclined ramp if the entrance is not at street level, and can open any doors); Access and use the rest facilities.

While this "minimal definition" does not specifically confirm the ADA specifications for accessibility, it may nevertheless serve as a guide. Please reply by phone, mail or email (firstvice@nassauny-aa(dot)org) to First Vice Chair at NI by April 1, 2010 or before. Based on your responses, NI will update the meeting lists.
